James B. Mox who departed this life
on the 4th Instant. made Statements in
our presence respecting his worldly estate
in the words following (To wit, That he
wished Bird Orange to take all his estate
into his hands, and pay all his Just debts
and reserve out of said estate Two hundred
Dollars to be paid to Hugh Mox for the
Legacy left him by his grand father George
Cox dec^d. And that his wife Elizabeth
Mox should have one third of the residue
of said estate, and the balance to be equally
divided Between Bird Orange and his two
youngest sons namely James, Washington
Mox and Joseph Goodwin Mox. and that
Richard Pigg nor Hugh Mox should have
no part of said estate or be in any way
Benefitted thereby. Witness our hands this
8th December 1828.
